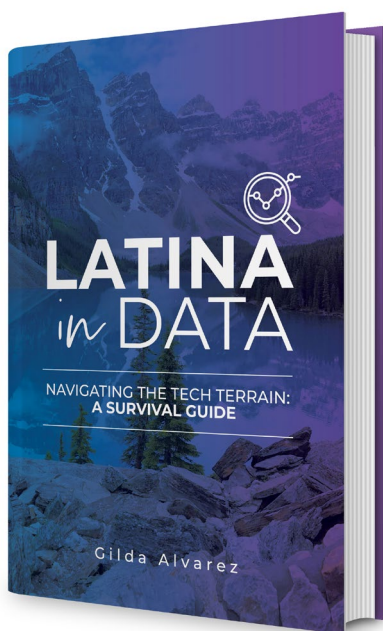
MY JOURNEY: FROM SMALL BEGINNINGS TO BIG DATA DREAMS:

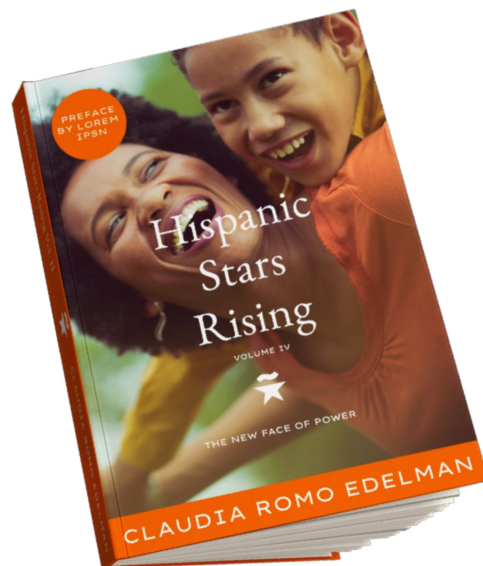
